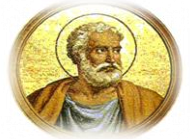

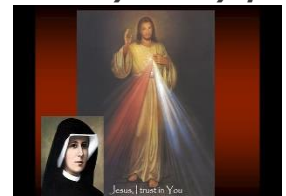
Rosary Sunday
