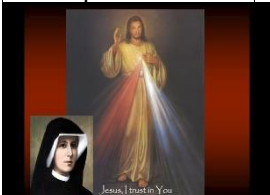
Divine Mercy weekly quote:

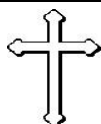
