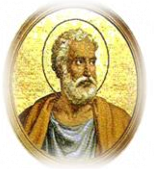

ACT OF PERFECT CONTRITION

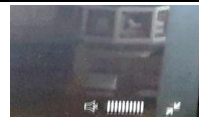
