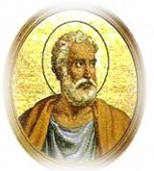

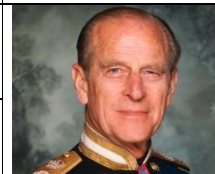

Saturday 10th 6:00pm	Holy Mass – Divine Mercy Blessings – Mr and Mrs Taylor	The Feast of The Divine Mercy Our Lord asked Saint Faustina to pray and work towards establishing a Feast of The Divine Mercy on the Sunday after Easter. He told her: <i>On that day, the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. (Diary, 699)</i> It is a day that would celebrate the paschal mystery with a focus on God's covenant of mercy. It would be a day of complete forgiveness and pardon, like the day of atonement in the Old Testament – all our sins and the punishment due to them would be atoned for.

ACT OF PERFECT CONTRITION

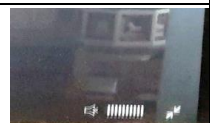
