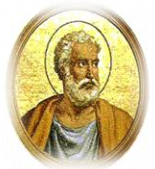

Month of May – The month of Mary

Our Parish loves our Blessed Lady. We cry out in song *"Oh Mary we crown thee with blossoms today, queen of the angels and queen of the May"*. We crown her statue and we come before her in prayer.

The Rosary is a wonderful form of prayer. The Rosary is made up of twenty "mysteries" (significant events of the life of Jesus and Mary), which, following the Apostolic Letter Rosarium Virginis Mariae, are grouped into four series. The first contains the **Joyful Mysteries** (recited on Mondays and Saturdays); the second, the **Mysteries of Light** (Thursdays); the third, the **Sorrowful Mysteries** (Tuesdays and Fridays); and the fourth, the **Glorious Mysteries** (Wednesdays and Sundays). I encourage every family to try to find time to pray the Rosary. This will bring you many blessings.





ACT OF PERFECT CONTRITION

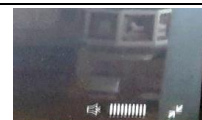
