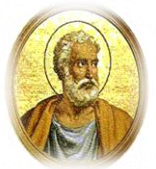

ACT OF PERFECT CONTRITION

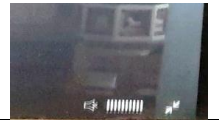

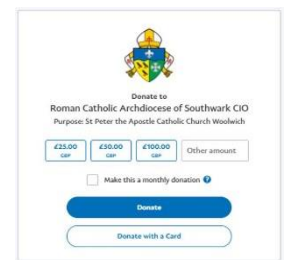
