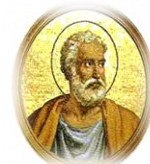

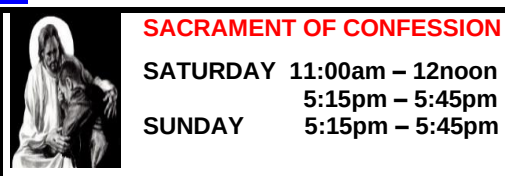

CATHOLIC BISHOPS' CONFERENCE OF ENGLAND AND WALES - Covid-19 Route Map: Step 4 Guidance

Recommended Key Mitigating Actions against Virus Transmission in Churches which should continue post 19th July 2021 include the following:

- **Sanitising hands** on entry to churches and before liturgies as in current church guidance reduces risk;
- **Ensuring people wear face coverings properly** will reduce aerosol or droplet spread;
- **Ventilating buildings well** remains important;
- **Maintaining a good general standard of routine cleaning** using usual cleaning detergents is sufficient for regular use;
- It is recommended that Holy Water stoups are **NOT** refilled;
- It is recommended that the **physical Sign of Peace remain suspended**;
- **Holy Communion will continue to be under one kind** and the ministers will continue to sanitise their hands beforehand and wear a face covering whilst distributing. Communion is recommended to be distributed in the hand but those who wish to receive on the tongue may do so at the end.
