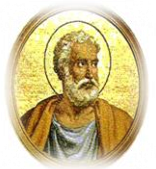

Trevor earlier this year received acknowledgement from 'Her Majesty the Queen' and will be receiving a prestigious National Medal of Honor in January. ELEVATE aims to support young people from disadvantaged backgrounds gain the skills, knowledge & experiences needed for the world of work & higher education. Trevor rapidly expanded the programme during lockdown, which is now reaching over 10,000 students. The programme runs a series of different schemes, combining workshops with 1:1 mentoring, covering a range of topics helping young people improve skills for presentations, interviews & networking, as well as providing guidance on careers & CVs, building an online presence & personal branding, boosting wellbeing & resilience. ACT OF PERFECT CONTRITION

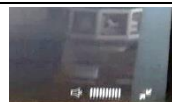
