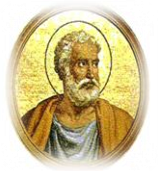

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION - FOR ADULTS 2022-2023 - WANT TO BECOME A CATHOLIC?

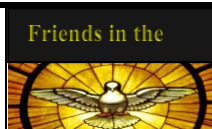
