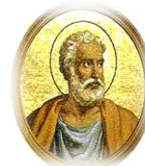

I would like to thank also Father Michael Branch, his ministry is a tough act to follow. The office of the pastor is a huge opportunity on my part to share in the ministry of Jesus Christ the Chief Shepherd of the Universal Church. I feel unworthy to assume this office knowing my handicap as a person but with the help of the Holy Spirit I feel empowered to accept the challenge of the pastoral work. In my mind this is not just a personal journey, it is as well a community task to animate the secular world with the word of God. We have a huge challenge as a community knowing that our society is deeply penetrated by the secular values. The challenges of our generation are peculiar to our own period. STATEMENT FROM ARCHBISHOP JOHN WILSON, ARCHBISHOP OF SOUTHWARK ON THE DEATH OF HER MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH II

The announcement of the death of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II is a cause of great sadness for her beloved family, for the United Kingdom, the Commonwealth, and all people of goodwill.

We give thanks to Almighty God for Her Majesty's life of unfailing dedication and the outstanding example of Her Majesty's service, faithful unto death.

As a devoted disciple of the Lord Jesus Christ, Her Majesty witnessed to the Gospel of God's love for all people and worked tirelessly to strengthen harmony, to defend justice and to promote peace. We now pray for the repose of her soul, remembering the promise of Christ, who is the Resurrection and the life: 'I am with you always, even until the end of time.' (Mt 28:20) May Her Majesty rest in peace and rise in glory.

We pray for our King, for the Queen Consort and for all the Royal Family at this time of bereavement. We offer to them our deepest sympathy and condolence.

Let us also pray for our United Kingdom and the Commonwealth, grateful to God for Queen Elizabeth II's remarkable life and selfless commitment to the promises she made at her Coronation. Her Majesty has been a part of all our lives and we shall miss her deeply. We beseech you Almighty God, that your servant Elizabeth, who by your mercy received the government of this realm, and who dedicated her life entirely to the service of her people, may now rest from her labours in the peace of Christ which surpasses all understanding. 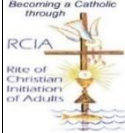
DATE FOR YOUR DIARY

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents wishing their children to be baptised in **OCTOBER** should attend the following Pre-Baptism Programme on **Tuesday 27th September 2022**.

This programme will start at 7pm and end at 9pm and will be held in Pugin Place. You are reminded that you need to meet with one of the parish clergy before attending this Session. You will find them available on Thursday evenings during Parish Surgery. We request **ALL PARENTS**, who wish to get their child baptised in the future, to bring their own baptism certificates along with their request form as proof that they are Catholics when they attend Parish Surgery. **GODPARENTS** will need to get a letter from their parish priest to say they are practicing Catholics.



Those attending the above Session will get their children baptised on the dates below:

Holy Baptism will be on Sunday 9th October 2022 and Sunday 23rd October 2022 after the 11:45am Mass

Points to note when choosing a Godparent for your child

- A godparent must be someone who has been chosen by the parents;
- has received the three sacraments of initiation: baptism, confirmation and Eucharist;
- is old enough to be a responsible godparent (at least 16 years old);
- is living the life of a believing and practising Catholic.

How many godparents can a child have?

The custom in most places is to have two godparents', but one godparent, male or female, is all that is required.

Can a child have two godfathers or two godmothers?

If there are two godparents, there must be one of each gender.

Can a non-Catholic be a godparent?

A baptised and believing Christian who is not a Catholic can act as a Christian witness, but not as a godparent.

If my godchild's parents die, do I become the legal guardian?

Many people think this is part of the role of the godparent, but the answer is no, unless you have also agreed to be the child's legal guardian.
