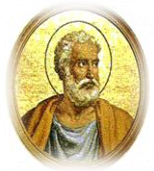

The Kingdom of Christ the King

In other words, to attain this Kingdom, we must live daily in the thought of St Augustine: *"Oh God, you have made us for yourself, and our hearts are restless until they rest in you"*.

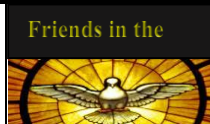
