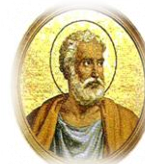

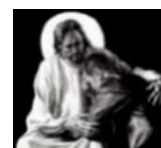

Easter Saturday Vigil: 8:00pm

In addition, you might consider attending the **Chrism Mass at St George's Cathedral at 11.00am on Wednesday 16th April** during which the priests throughout the diocese renew their priestly promises and the Archbishop blesses the Holy Oils for the year ahead. The Chrism Mass is always a very uplifting and inspirational experience.
