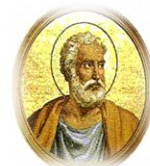

TEA AND COFFEE MORNING



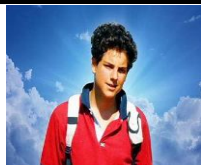
