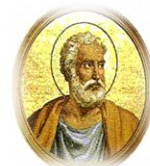

PENTECOST SUNDAY (YEAR C)



Pentecost is regarded as the birth date of the Christian church and was key in expanding the number of early Christian believers. In the UK, Pentecost is also called “Whitsunday” or “Whitsun”. Following Jesus' resurrection after the crucifixion, he remained among his friends and family for forty days. On the fortieth day after the Resurrection, the Book of Acts describes how Jesus ascended into heaven, after promising the watching disciples that they would not have to wait long for the Holy Spirit to come and guide them. Ten days later the disciples were gathered together in a house in Jerusalem. Suddenly they heard a sound like a roaring wind and saw what seemed to be fire coming to rest on each of their heads. This noise and the vision of flames represented the coming of the Holy Spirit.

DAY FOR LIFE 2025
